RE: Proposed change in flight patterns from Centennial Airport

Dear Sir or Madam:

I am writing you as the Board president of the HighPointe Homeowners Association. The eighty-six families who reside within the association, bounded by Carson Court on the East, Cherry Creek State Park on the West, Cherry Creek Rancho on the South and Cherry Creek Villas on the North, are opposed to any change in current approved flight patterns which will bring more aircraft in landing and take-off patterns above our homeowners property or that of our near neighbors. The map coordinates of the HighPointe Association are approximately N 39 37 and W 104 49.

We appreciate that Centennial Airport is a community asset, but aircraft in landing and take-off patterns are already very low over our heads and quite loud. We do not want change which will increase either the frequency of flights over our heads or the loudness of those flights or reduce their altitude.
