

What can we do to reduce the expanding noise from flights that are now being directed over our neighborhood? We have lived in Willow Creek since 1981. Traffic patterns have significantly changed, where planes, jets and helicopter traffic patterns are now routed directly over our neighborhood, when they could instead, be directed over the I-25 or C-470 highway corridors.

Also, with the new Sky Ridge Hospital completed at I-25 and Lincoln Road, the hospital has a LOW FLYING, NOISY, helicopter that flies directly over our house at all hours of the day and night. The hospital is located a stones throw off I-25, just south of Lincoln Road. Again, why couldn't that flight pattern be adjusted directly along the I-25 corridor, instead of 500 feet directly over our sleeping community at 2AM?!
