

I am writing in response to federal register notice no. 73 FR 9847. I live in a residential neighborhood near Centennial Airport in Centennial, Colorado. When I purchased this house I did not know there would be as much air traffic noise as there is. I hear planes most of the day and even sometimes as late as 2:00am. I understand that I am supposed to monitor those late planes and call the airport but who wants to get up and do this in the middle of the night?

My biggest concern with the proposed guidelines are the times that the planes will be allowed to fly. It seems that all aircraft will be allowed to fly up until 10:00pm. If you have young children, as I do, they are in bed well before 10:00pm. Some of the aircraft are very loud as they pass over and have awoken the children at night. I would rather see the time changed from 10:00pm to 8:00pm.

I also wonder why the planes are allowed to fly so close to the school in our neighborhood. The school in our neighborhood is called Lone Tree Elementary School. It is a Douglas County, Colorado public school. I had thought there were laws about flying over schools at such a close range?
