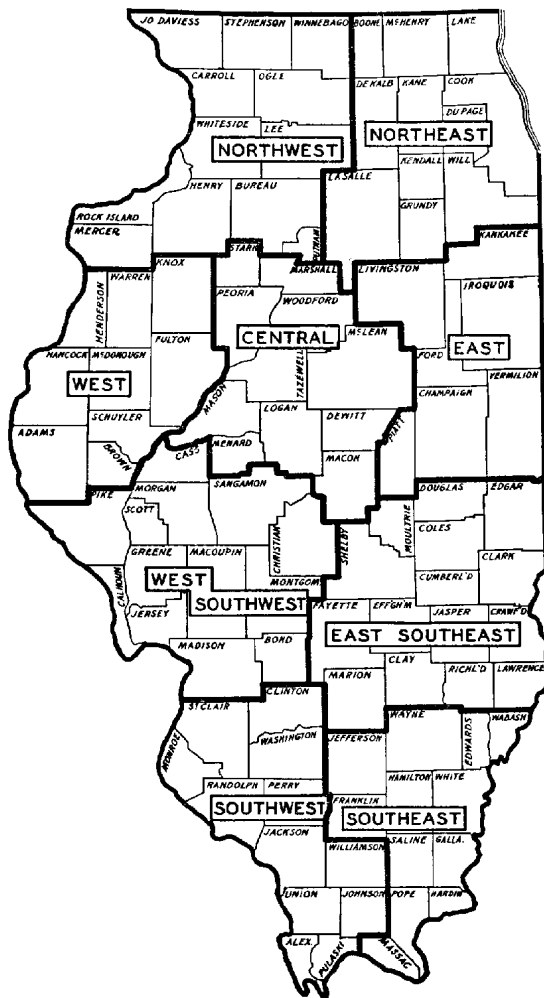

ILLINOIS ANNUAL CROP SUMMARY 2007

RECORD CORN PRODUCTION

Production of corn for grain totaled 2.284 billion bushels in 2007, 26 percent more than last year and the largest production on record for Illinois. The final yield was 175 bushels per acre, the second highest yield on record behind 180 in 2004. There were 13.2 million acres planted to corn in Illinois in 2007. After getting off to a slow start due to cold weather, most of the state's corn crop was planted during the last two weeks of April. Excellent growing conditions during June and early July had the corn crop advancing in maturity at a rapid pace. However, dry weather in the southern half of the state reduced yields. Harvest got off to a good start in early September and progressed at a record pace.

SOYBEAN YIELD DOWN

The final yield for the 2007 soybean crop was 43.0 bushels per acre, five bushels below the 2006 yield. Production in 2007 reached 350.45 million bushels, 27 percent below 2006. Acres planted in 2007 were down 1.9 million from 2006 to 8.2 million. The growing season started off dry, with high temperatures throughout the season. As harvest

began, temperatures were above average across the state, as was precipitation. Harvest activities were slightly delayed due to weather conditions.

WHEAT YIELD DOWN FROM RECORD YEAR IN 2006

The final yield for the 2007 winter wheat crop was 57 bushels per acre, down ten bushels from last year's yield. Acreage seeded in the fall of 2006 was 1.0 million acres, up 70 thousand acres from 2005. Farmers harvested 890 thousand acres for grain, down two percent from the previous year. This resulted in a total production of 50.7 million bushels, 17 percent less than the 2006 production.

OAT PRODUCTION DOWN

The final oat estimate for 2007 placed the production at 1.63 million bushels, 47 percent below the 2006 production. Acreage harvested for grain, at 24 thousand, was down 16 thousand acres from the previous year. The final yield, at 68 bushels per acre, was nine bushels below 2006.

SORGHUM AFFECTED BY DRY CONDITIONS

The final 2007 yield for sorghum for grain was 81 bushels per acre, eight bushels below the yield in 2006. Production, at 6.237 million bushels, was down three percent from the previous year. Dry conditions in southern Illinois played a large part in the decrease in yield. The total planted acres of sorghum were 80,000, with 77,000 acres harvested for grain.

HAY PRODUCTION DOWN

Production of all hay in 2007 was 1.92 million tons, 24 percent less than in 2006. Alfalfa hay production was down 22 percent to 1.41 million tons while all other hay production decreased 28 percent to 510 thousand tons. Yields averaged 3.7 tons per acre for alfalfa hay and 1.7 tons per acre for all other hay. Alfalfa acreage cut for hay was 380 thousand in 2007, down 14 percent from 2006. Acreage of all other hay cut was 300 thousand, down 20 thousand from 2006.

POTATO YIELD INCREASES

Illinois potato producers harvested 6,100 acres in 2007, down from 6,300 acres in 2006. Production decreased to 2.44 million cwt. The 2007 potato yield of 400 cwt. per acre was up from the previous year's 395 cwt. per acre.

FRESH MARKET SWEET CORN

Fresh market sweet corn acreage harvested was up two percent from 2006 to 6,600 acres and the yield increased to 110 cwt. per acre, up from the 2006 yield of 71. Production was up 57 percent from 2006.

SNAP BEANS FOR PROCESSING

Snap bean growers produced 57.1 thousand tons, up one percent from 2006. The yield, at 4.65 tons per acre, was up 22 percent from 2006. Acreage harvested, at 12,300, was down 17 percent from the previous year.

CABBAGE FOR FRESH MARKET

Harvested acres increased to 800 and production rose to 224,000 cwt. This was an increase of 28 percent from the previous year's production. The yield was up from 2006 to 280 cwt. per acre.

PUMPKIN PRODUCTION

Illinois pumpkin growers harvested 13,800 acres for fresh market and processing, up nine percent from the previous year. Production, at 5.42 million cwt., was ten percent above 2006.

APPLE PRODUCTION

Illinois apple growers utilized 4.9 million pounds produced in 2007. This was down from the 2006 level of 44.8 million pounds. The Easter freeze reduced apple production significantly.

PEACH PRODUCTION

Illinois utilized peach production during 2007 totaled 90 tons. Production was down from the 2006 level of 10,740 tons due to the Easter freeze.
