Clark County is a county located in the state of Illinois. The County was formed in 1819 out of Crawford County. At the time of its formation, Clark County included about a third of Illinois. It acquired its present boundaries in 1831 as new counties were formed out of it. Its county seat is Marshall, Illinois.

Clark County was named for George Rogers Clark, an officer of the army of Virginia that captured the Northwest Territory from the British at the close of the Revolutionary War.

Clark Co Geography

According to the U.S. Census Bureau, the county has a total area of 1,308 km (505 mi). 1,299 km (502 mi) of it is land and 9 km (3 mi) of it is water. The total area is 0.67% water.
