

Cook County was created in 1831 by an act of the Illinois State Legislature. It was the 54th county established in Illinois and was named after Daniel Pope Cook, one of the earliest and youngest statesmen in Illinois history.

According to the U.S. Census Bureau, the county has a total area of 4,235 km (1,635 mi). 2,449 km (946 mi) of it is land and 1,785 km (689 mi) of it is water. The total area is 42.16% water
