

Edgar County is a county located in the state of Illinois. Its county seat is Paris.

Edgar County was formed in 1823 out of Clark County. It was named for John Edgar, an early settler of Illinois. John Edgar's name appears on an 1809 list of militia men who served in Illinois prior to 1790.

Edgar County Geography

According to the U.S. Census Bureau, the county has a total area of 1,617 km (624 mi). 1,615 km (624 mi) of it is land and 2 km (1 mi) of it is water. The total area is 0.10% water.
