Jefferson County is a county located in the state of Illinois. Its county seat is Mt. Vernon.

Jefferson County was organized in 1819, out of pieces of White, Edwards and Franklin Counties. It was named in honor of Thomas Jefferson, principle draftsman of the Northwest Ordinance, among other things. The baseline crosses the Third Principal Meridian at the northwest corner of the County.

Jefferson Co Geography

According to the U.S. Census Bureau, the county has a total area of 1,512 km (584 mi). 1,479 km (571 mi) of it is land and 33 km (13 mi) of it is water. The total area is 2.19% water.
