These four programs are designed to help build the teaching, extension, and research capacities of the 1994 Land-Grant Institutions, commonly referred to as the Tribal Colleges and Universities (TCUs), in the food and agricultural sciences.

- Tribal Colleges Education Equity Program enhances educational opportunities for American Indians.
- Tribal Colleges Endowment Fund provides flexible, educational development opportunities for faculty and students at the TCUs.
- Tribal Colleges Extension Program supports nonformal education and outreach programs.
- Tribal Colleges Research Program investigates highpriority agricultural concerns of tribal, national, or multistate significance.



Who May Apply

Institutions designated as 1994 Land-Grant Institutions are eligible to receive funding through or apply for grants in these programs.
