

## HOG SLAUGHTER

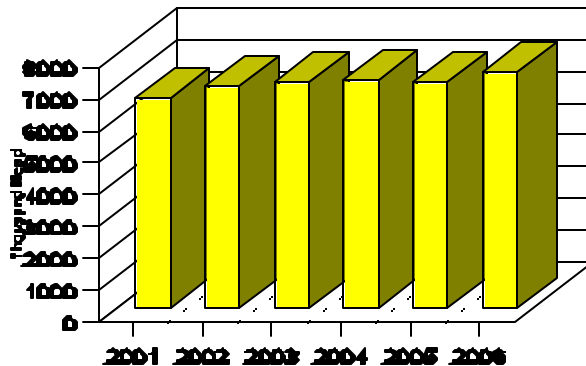
Slaughter production for hogs during 2006 in Indiana totaled 1.95 billion pounds, an increase of 4 percent from the 2005 figure of 1.87 billion pounds. There were 7.39 million hogs slaughtered, up 4 percent from 2005. The average weight per hog, at 264 pounds, was down 1 pound from 2005.
