Cattaraugus County Farm Statistics

Cattaraugus county lies in the southwestern part of the state bordering Pennsylvania. In 2003, there were 201,600 acres in farms, 24 percent of the county's total 838,305 acres. There were 1,150 farms in the county averaging 175 acres per farm. Cattaraugus county ranks 5th in the state for number of farms and 11th for land in farms.

In 2002, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$58.4 million. Total sales averaged \$50,434 per farm. The leading products sold were: dairy products, nursery & greenhouse, cattle & calves, hay & silage, and silage, and grains & dry beans.

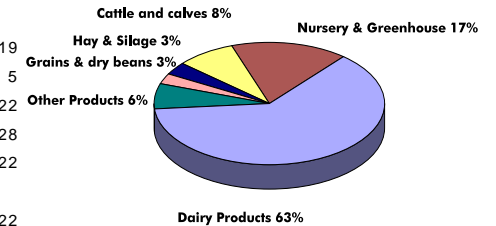
The average value of land and buildings per farm was \$218,769. Machinery and equipment was valued at \$92,376 per farm. Total production expenses in 1997 were \$58.9 million for an average of \$50,928 per farm. The Census showed 54 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 53.8 years. Data from the U.S. Department of Commerce showed the median household income in 1999 was \$33,404.

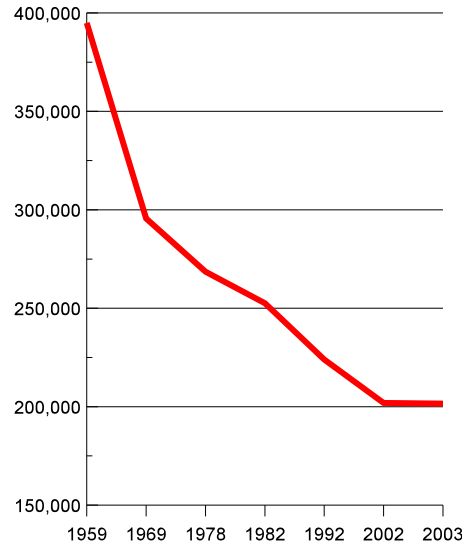

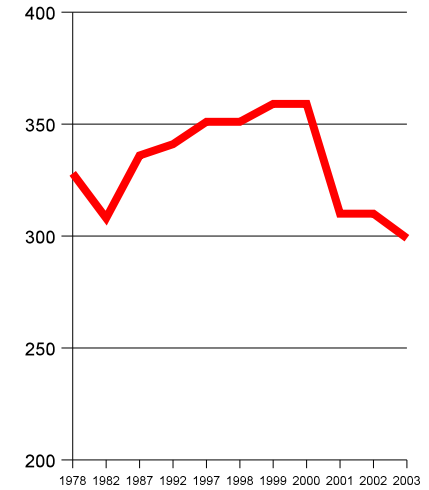
