Farm Statistics

Cayuga county lies in the west central area of the state in the Finger Lakes Region bordering Lake Ontario. In 2003, there were 237,800 acres in farms, 54 percent of the county's total 443,638 acres. There were 875 farms in the county averaging 272 acres per farm. Cayuga county ranks 13th in the state for number of farms and 5th for land in farms.

In 2002, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$128 million. Total sales averaged \$145,334 per farm. The leading products sold were: dairy products, field crops, cattle & calves, vegetables, and nursery & greenhouse.

The average value of land and buildings per farm was \$383,708. Machinery and equipment was valued at \$139,374 per farm. Total production expenses in 2002 were \$110.3 million for an average of \$125,325 per farm. The Census showed 62 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 54.1 years. Data from the U.S. Department of Commerce showed the median household income in 1999 was \$37,487.




