Farm Statistics

Franklin county is located in the northern part of the state in the Adirondack mountains bordering Canada. In 2003, there were 138,000 acres in farms, 13 percent of the county's total 1,044,152 acres. There were 530 farms in the county averaging 260 acres per farm. Franklin county ranks 40th in the state for number of farms and 26th for land in farms.

In 2002, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$48 million. Total sales averaged \$90,231 per farm. The leading products sold were: dairy products, cattle & calves, vegetables, aquaculture, and nursery & greenhouse.


The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2002 was 206,475. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$81,641 per farm. Total production expenses in 2002 were \$43.6 million for an average of \$81,124 per farm. The Census showed 68 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 53.2 years. Data from the U.S. Department of Commerce showed the median household income in 1999 was \$31,517.




