Farm Statistics

Fulton county is located in the east central portion of the state at the base of the Adirondack mountains. In 2003, there were 37,700 acres in farms, 12 percent of the county's total 317,546 acres. There were 245 farms in the county averaging 154 acres per farm. Fulton county ranks 49th in the state for number of farms and 49th for land in farms.

In 2002, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$8.4 million. Total sales averaged \$34,241 per farm. The leading products sold were: dairy products, cattle & calves, hay & other crops, fruits & nuts, and vegetables.

The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2002 was \$264,970. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$60,232 per farm. Total production expenses in 2002 were \$8 million for an average of \$32,328 per farm. The Census showed 56 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 55.7 years. Data from the U.S. Department of Commerce showed the median household income in 1999 was \$33,663.




