# Herkimer County

## Farm Statistics

Herkimer County is located in the north central part of the state in the Adirondack mountains. In 2003, there were 159,100 acres in farms, 18 percent of the county's total 903,200 acres. There were 685 farms in the county averaging 232 acres per farm. Herkimer county ranks 24th in the state for number of farms and 22nd for land in farms.

In 2002, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$49.8 million. Total sales averaged \$72,213 per farm. The leading products sold were: dairy products, cattle & calves, vegetables, hay & other crops, and nursery & greenhouse.

The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2002 was \$258,994. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$68,458 per farm. Total production expenses in 2002 were \$37.1 million for an average of \$53,862 per farm. The Census showed 66 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 54.1 years. Data from the U.S. Department of Commerce showed the median household income in 1999 was \$32,924.




