Farm Statistics

Lewis County is located in the northern part of the State bordering the western edge of the Adirondack mountains. In 2003, there were 196,500 acres in farms, 24 percent of the county's total 816,271 acres. There were 720 farms in the county averaging 273 acres per farm. Lewis County ranks 22nd in the state for number of farms and 12th for land in farms.

In 2002, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$72.2 million. Total sales averaged \$100,108 per farm. The leading products sold were: dairy products, cattle & calves, hay & other crops, vegetables and grains & dry beans.

The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2002 was \$219,952. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$103,351 per farm. Total production expenses in 2002 were \$58.3 million for an average of \$80,921 per farm. The Census showed 70 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 52 years. Data from the U.S. Department of Commerce showed the median household income in 1999 was \$34,361.




