Farm Statistics

Oneida County is located in central New York. In 2003, there were 220,200 acres in farms, 28 percent of the county's total 776,130 acres. There were 1,080 farms in the county averaging 204 acres per farm. Oneida County ranks 6th in the state for number of farms and 6th for land in farms.

In 2002, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$78.4 million. Total sales averaged \$72,098 per farm. The leading products sold were: dairy products, vegetables, cattle & calves, nursery & greenhouse, and grains & dry beans.


The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2002 was \$225,598. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$74,100 per farm. Total production expenses in 2002 were \$58.4 million for an average of \$53,711 per farm. The Census showed 64 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 53.3 years. The Department of Commerce showed the median household income in 1999 was \$35,909.


