Farm Statistics

Ontario County is located in the Finger Lakes Region of west central New York. In 2003, there were 194,400 acres in farms, 47 percent of the county's total 412,404 acres. There were 890 farms in the county averaging 218 acres per farm. Ontario County ranks 11th in the state for number of farms and 13th for land in farms.

In 2002, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$87.1 million. Total sales averaged \$97,184 per farm. The leading products sold were: dairy products, vegetables, grains & dry beans, cattle & calves, and nursery & greenhouse.


The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2002 was \$355,018. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$115,577 per farm. Total production expenses in 2002 were \$74.9 million for an average of \$83,840 per farm. The Census showed 62 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 53.5 years. The Department of Commerce showed the median household income in 1999 was \$44,579.


