

## Rockland County

Farm Statistics

Rockland County lies in the Hudson Valley Region bordering New York City. In 2003, there were 1,000 acres in farms, 1 percent of the county's total 111,500 acres. There were 30 farms in the county averaging 33 acres per farm. Rockland county ranks 56th in the state for number of farms and 59th for land in farms.

In 2002, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$3.2 million. Total sales averaged \$108,939 per farm. The leading products sold were: nursery & greenhouse, fruits & nuts, and vegetables.

The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2002 was \$1,075,563. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$68,688 per farm. Total production expenses in 2002 were \$3.2 million for an average of \$111,798 per farm. The Census showed 59 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 55.8 years. Data from the U.S. Department of Commerce showed the median household income in 1999 was \$67,971


