Farm Statistics

Sullivan County is located in southern New York on the southwestern edge of the Catskill mountains bordering Pennsylvania. In 2003, there were 63,500 acres in farms, 10 percent of the county's total 620,618 acres. There were 380 farms in the county averaging 167 acres per farm. Sullivan county ranks 47th in the state for number of farms and 46th for land in farms.

In 2002, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$37.8 million. Total sales averaged \$99,090 per farm. The leading products sold were: poultry and eggs, dairy products, hay & other crops, horses & ponies, and nursery & greenhouse.

The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2002 was \$522,088. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$72,534 per farm. Total production expenses in 2002 were \$26.5 million for an average of \$69,383 per farm. The Census showed 64 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 54.8 years. Data from the U.S. The U.S. Department of Commerce showed the median household income in 1999 was \$36,998.






