Farm Statistics

Wyoming County is located in the western part of New York State. In 2003, there were 215,000 acres in farms, 57 percent of the county's total 379,465 acres. There were 760 farms in the county averaging 283 acres per farm. Wyoming county ranks 18th in the state for number of farms and 7th for land in farms.

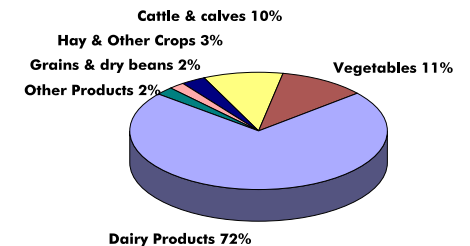
In 2002, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$178.0 million. Total sales averaged \$232,078 per farm. The leading products sold were: dairy products, vegetables, cattle & calves, hay & other crops, and grains & dry beans.

The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2002 was \$ 390,945. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$168,143 per farm. Total production expenses in 2002 were \$152 million for an average of \$197,904 per farm. The Census showed 68 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 52.2 years. Data from the U.S. Department of Commerce showed the average personal income for all wage earners in the county in 1999 was \$39,895.

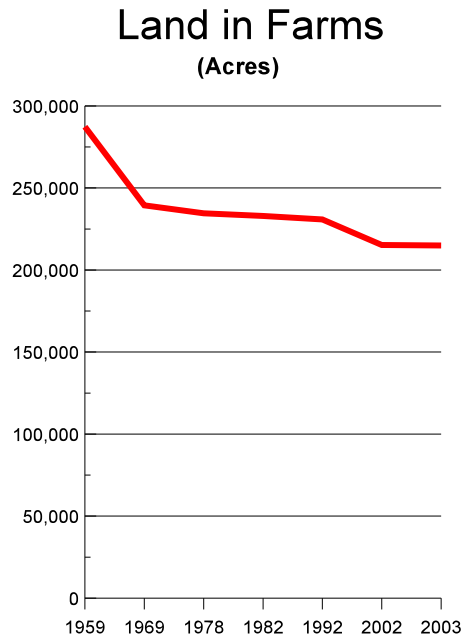
