Farm Statistics

Yates County is located in west central New York in the Finger Lakes region. In 2003, there were 114,900 acres in farms, 53 percent of the county's total 216,471 acres. There were 715 farms in the county averaging 161 acres per farm. Yates county ranks 21st in the state for number of farms and 32nd for land in farms.

In 2002, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$50.4 million. Total sales averaged \$69,769 per farm. The leading products sold were: dairy products, fruits & nuts, vegetables, cattle & calves, and grains & dry beans.

The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2002 was \$281,899. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$75,985 per farm. Total production expenses in 2002 were \$37.7 million for an average of \$52,047 per farm. The Census showed 67 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 48.3 years. Data from the U.S. Department of Commerce showed the median household income in 1999 was \$34,640.




