Farm Statistics

Delaware county is located in the southern part of the state in the Catskill mountains. In 2003, there were 190,300 acres in farms, 21 percent of the county's total 925,679 acres. There were 780 farms in the county averaging 244 acres per farm. Delaware county ranks 17th in the state for number of farms and 14th for land in farms.

In 2002, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$50.5 million. Total sales averaged \$64,111 per farm. The leading products sold were: dairy Products, cattle & calves, nursery & greenhouse, hay & other crops, and Christmas trees.

The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2002 was \$405,821. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$72,854 per farm. Total production expenses in 2002 were \$46.2 million for an average of \$58,502 per farm. The Census showed 63 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 55 years. Data from the U.S. Department of Commerce showed the median household income in 1999 was \$32,461.






