Farm Statistics

Ulster County is located in the Catskill Mountains in the Hudson River Valley of New York. In 2003, there were 83,300 acres in farms, 12 percent of the county's total 720,945 acres. There were 530 farms in the county averaging 157 acres per farm. Ulster county ranks 39th in the state for number of farms and 41st for land in farms.

In 2002, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$34.4 million. Total sales averaged \$64,692 per farm. The leading products sold were: fruits & nuts, vegetables, nursery & greenhouse, hay & other crops, and horses & ponies.

The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2002 was \$534,962. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$81,821 per farm. Total production expenses in 2002 were \$36.2 million for an average of \$68,105 per farm. The Census showed 64 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 54.5 years. Data from the U.S. Department of Commerce showed the median household income in 1999 was \$42,551.




