Farm Statistics

Westchester County is located in southeastern New York near New York City. In 2003, there were 9,900 acres in farms, 4 percent of the county's total 277,007 acres. There were 130 farms in the county averaging 76 acres per farm. Westchester county ranks 52nd in the state for number of farms and 52nd for land in farms.

In 2002, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$8.9 million. Total sales averaged \$68,637 per farm. The leading products sold were: nursery & greenhouse, vegetables, fruits & nuts, horses & ponies, and hay & other crops.

The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2002 was \$1,087,369. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$64,567 per farm. Total production expenses in 2002 were \$11.8 million for an average of \$92,095 per farm. The Census showed 58 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 56.8 years. The Department of Commerce showed the median household income in 1999 was \$63,582.


