<u>Canopy</u> - The portion of the riparian area that provides overhead cover. (Trees)

<u>Macroinvertebrates</u> - Animals without backbones which you can see without a microscope.

<u>Riffles</u> - Area in-between the pools where rocks break the surface of the water.

<u>Riparian Zone</u> - The area of vegetation adjacent to the stream composed of some leafy plants, shrubs, and trees.

<u>Site</u> - A location within the stream reach where detailed study takes place.

<u>Temperature</u> - Water temperature controls many of a streams biological and chemical process.

Watershed - An area which surrounds and drains into a body of water.
