

What Exactly Did SNS Achieve as Compared with Other DOE or BLS Statistics for Construction Safety?



INJURY RATE STATISTICS

DART Case Rate:

- DOE Average (2000- 2006): 1.3 (27 cases)
- Bureau of Labor Statistics (00-06): 3.8 (80 cases)
- SNS (00-06): 1.0 (22 cases)

DAYS AWAY RATE:

- DOE Average (2000- 2006): 0.38 (8 cases)
- Bureau of Labor Statistics (00-06): 2.8 (59 cases)
- SNS (00-06): 0 (0 cases)

(Based on 4.2 Million Hours Worked)

Proactive Case Management is Vital

- Hire Occupational MDs that Understand Work Environment
- ☐ 3 Company Doctors; 1 Full time Nurse -Onsite
- ☐ Managed Medical Treatment
- Active Communication with Case Manager on Available Work that Meets Restrictions

Involvement of Craft and Local Business Agents

- Recognition/Incentive Programs (Safe Work Crew of the Month, Give Aways, etc.)
- Willingness to do Administrative Duties on Restrictions

Personal Attention by DOE Line Management and Senior Contactor Management Must be More Than Visual

- ☐ Active Participation by Leading
- Actively Engaged in Safety Topics and Discussions
- Personal Involvement in Incident Investigations
