1997 CENSUS OF AGRICULTURE

Results of the 1997 Census of Agriculture are published in a series of reports that provide data at the national, State, and county (or equivalent) levels for the United States. Data also are available for Puerto Rico, Guam, U.S. Virgin Islands, and the Commonwealth of Northern Mariana Islands.

VOLUME 1. GEOGRAPHIC AREA SERIES (AC97-A-1 TO 55)

National, State, and county data are published in detailed national and State tables for the United States, and in State and county tables for each State. These reports include data on number and size of farm; crop production; livestock, poultry, and their products; tenure, age, and principal occupation of operator; type of organization; value of products sold; government payments plus market value of agricultural products sold; production expenses; direct marketing; number of hired employees; land use; irrigation; and the NAICS classification of farms.

VOLUME 2. SUBJECT SERIES (AC97-S-1 TO 3)

Agricultural Atlas of the United States (AC97-S-1) graphically illustrates a profile of the Nation's agriculture at the county level in a series of dot and multicolor pattern maps. The maps provide displays on sizes and types of farms, land use, farm tenure, market value of agricultural products sold, crops harvested, livestock inventories, and other characteristics of farms.

Ranking of States and Counties (AC97-S-2) ranks the leading States and counties for selected items from the 1997 Census of Agriculture. Tables show cumulative percent of U.S. totals and most include comparative data from the 1992 census.

ZIP Code Tabulations of Selected Items (AC97-S-3) contains the 1997 and the 1992 farms by ZIP Code. The product is ZIP Code tabulations from the respective Censuses of Agriculture and provides tabulations by five-digit ZIP Code for selected data items. Data items include total number of farms, land in farms, farms by size, market value of agricultural products sold by size of sales, livestock inventory, cropland harvested, selected crops, and other data.

VOLUME 3. SPECIAL STUDIES (Parts 1-4)

1998 Farm and Ranch Irrigation Survey (Part 1) report provides data collected from a sample of irrigated farm operations identified in the 1997 Census of Agriculture. Data items include acres irrigated, land use, yields of specified crops, methods of water distribution, quantity of water used by source, expenses, and other irrigation practices.

1998 Census of Horticultural Specialties (Part 2) report includes detailed information on the horticultural operations with production and sales of \$10,000 or more. It provides data on number of operations, value of sales of horticultural crops, type of horticultural crops, and kinds of horticultural businesses for the United States, States, and counties.

1998 Census of Aquaculture (Part 3) report is the first ever national aquaculture census that provides a broad picture of the industry's size and diversity. It provides the only national and State level source of uniform, comprehensive information about aquaculture. Data includes size of operation, production, method of production, sales, point of first sales outlet, and other data.

1999 Agricultural Economics and Land Ownership Survey (Part 4) report provides data on indebtedness, expenditures, land ownership and assets for both farm operators and landlords. This report also includes measures of credit used for purchases and expenditure, debt by type of lender, assets, off-farm income, and other land ownership data.

SPECIALTY PRODUCTS

1997 Congressional Districts Tabulation Report (on CD-ROM) presents selected statistics for all of the congressional districts in the nation. Statistics provided include operators characteristics, farm characteristics, selected livestock inventories, and selected crops harvested. Also included are market value of agricultural products sold, and market value of livestock.

1997 Census of Agriculture Ranking of Congressional Districts Report presents selected statistics ranked by the leading congressional districts. These statistics include operator characteristics, farm characteristics, selected livestock inventories, and selected crops harvested.
