Facility Membership Information

Use of the *FITNESS AREA* and *EDUCATION ROOM* requires a free membership with the City of Tempe. Members must be 16 years and older to use the Fitness Area and 6 years and older to use the Education Room. A parent/legal guardian must fill out a membership form at the front desk with a valid State issued identification card. The Educa-


