MEMORANDUM FOR COMMANDER, DEFENSE REUTILIZATION AND MARKETING  
SERVICE

SUBJECT: Gas Masks

Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) and military services personnel recently discovered that certain Navy ND Mark V gas masks, with National Stock Numbers (NSNs) H-4240-01-268-9732 and 4240-00-268-9732, made available to other Federal, state, and local entities from 1995 through 2000, may no longer be suitable or effective for their originally intended purposes and are not approved by the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH). The masks require NIOSH approval if they are used by non-military personnel. Additionally, as a normal part of a respiratory protection program, fit testing the mask to the user is also required. Without the NIOSH certification and the personal fit testing, these masks may not provide the user the necessary or adequate protection.

In light of these concerns, I advise you to notify in writing all parties who can be identified as recipients of these masks (with the NSNs listed above) to take them out of service and dispose of the masks properly. This should include disposal of any canisters in accordance with U.S. Environmental Protection Agency requirements. You should also make more general notification in trade journals or other publications (including the DRMS RTD website) that can reasonably be expected to provide proper notice to recipients of these masks and suspend release of masks with these NSNs pending further review by the DoD Disposal Policy Working Group. In the alternative, you should advise recipients who wish to retain these masks to have such masks received with these NSNs tested and approved by NIOSH.
