- 2. Evaluating, in the context of the station blackout rule, what portion of the offsite power system are within the scope of license renewal.

The confirmatory issue pertained to including a statement in the supplemental Updated Final Safety Analysis Report that license renewal activities would conform to 10 CFR Part 50 Appendix B, "Quality Assurance Criteria for Nuclear Power Plants and Fuel Reprocessing Plants."
