**FY 2002 EMERGENCY SUPPLEMENTAL BILL** – On August 2, 2002 the President signed into law H.R. 4775, the FY 2002 Supplemental Appropriations Act. The legislation provides \$144 million in funding through the Emergency Watershed Protection Program to assist with recovery from natural disasters.

**EMERGENCY AGRICULTURAL ASSISTANCE MEETING-** On August 1, 2002, the Senate Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry Committee (Chairman Harkin, IA), held a meeting to discuss the need for legislation to provide emergency assistance to agricultural producers.
