FY 2002 EMERGENCY SUPPLEMENTAL BILL – The joint House and Senate conference on Supplemental Appropriations for FY 2002 was held on July 18, 2002. The Senate legislation contains a provision for \$144 million in funding through the Emergency Watershed Protection Program to assist with recovery from natural disasters. The legislation is expected to be taken up early in the week in both the House and Senate.
