Dear Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest User:

As you may have heard, a decision was made recently to merge the Uinta and Wasatch-Cache National Forests. In regards to this we are working to merge many of our systems. Two of the items to be merged are our Quarterly Schedule of Proposed Actions (SOPA), and our internet sites. Merger of these involves considerable work, and will take us some time to complete. We hope to have this completed later this year, but until that time we will still publish separate Uinta and a Wasatch-Cache National Forest SOPAs.

The enclosed SOPA details projects proposed on the Uinta National Forest which require environmental analysis. If you wish to comment on a specific project, the first step is to get a hold of the contact listed for that project, and request to be added to the project mailing list.
