FALCON investigators arrested Ordonez and Valls June 27 in Laredo, T.X. Ordonez and Valls were wanted, along with Rodolfo Quintanilla, by the Laredo Police Department for aggravated assault with a deadly weapon. During a fight at a party, the three subjects allegedly beat the victim, striking him in the face and head with beer bottles and other unknown objects until he was unconscious. When witnesses attempted to intervene, one of the subjects allegedly brandished a handgun and threatened the bystanders. The assailants fled the scene. At the time of the arrest, suspected narcotics, paraphernalia and firearms were observed in plain view. FALCON team members obtained a search warrant for the residence and the following items were seized from the residence: a .357 Smith and Wesson revolver; a .40 caliber Smith and Wesson handgun; a .22 cal. Smith and Wesson handgun; two 12 gauge Mossberg shotguns; a 7.62 AK47 assault rifle; six boxes of assorted ammunition; \$625; jewelry; 53 grams of cocaine packaged for individual sale; digital scales; materials used for narcotics packaging; and numerous magazines for various firearms. The subjects face additional charges including distribution of controlled substance, felon in possession of a firearm and possession of a firearm during a drug trafficking offense. The third subject, Quintanilla, was arrested the previous day by the Laredo Police Department.
