FALCON investigators arrested Latulippe June 3 on a Provisional Arrest Warrant in Hampton, N.H. The warrant for Latulippe's arrest was issued in the District of New Hampshire and related to a request from the government of Costa Rica. Authorities in that country sought Latulippe since 2006 for charges relating to an extensive investment fraud scheme. According to Costa Rican authorities, Latulippe allegedly defrauded numerous individuals of more than \$2.3 million. FALCON investigators developed information indicating Latulippe fled to a residence in Hampton. The FALCON team established surveillance at that site and later observed Latulippe riding in a vehicle. Investigators followed the vehicle, conducted a traffic stop and took Latulippe into custody. Latulippe currently remains in custody pending extradition to Costa Rica.
