FALCON investigators arrested Woods June 17 in Huntington, W.Va. Woods was wanted on two counts of sexual abuse by a parent or guardian in Cabell County, W.Va. Statements from the victim allege that on several occasions between September 2006 and December 2007 Woods had sexual contact and sexual intercourse with the victim, who was seven when the alleged abuse began. In the victim's statements, Woods had male friends come to the residence to watch Woods sexually abuse the child. The associates reportedly would laugh, take pictures, and blow marijuana and crack smoke into the victim's face. Woods also poured liquor into the victim's mouth on several occasions. Several times during the sexual assault of the victim, Woods would throw the victim down the stairs, on the bed, or into the bathtub causing bruises. Lastly, it was alleged that Woods cut the child's clothes off with scissors if the victim was not compliant to his demands. Information was received June 17 that Woods was staying at the Westwood Acres Apartments on the west end of Huntington, W.Va. FALCON investigators went to the apartment and came across Woods trying to flee over a fence behind the apartment. Officers surrounded Woods and took him into custody without incident.
