This letter is a follow up to one which you received dated September 13, 2004 concerning the consistency review process the Forest Service was going through during the period up to December 31, 2006.

This process would result in the determination of whether current recreation residence special use permits were consistent or might not be consistent with the Pike \& San Isabel National Forests, Cimarron and Comanche National Grasslands (PSICC) current Land and Resource Management Plan (LRMP) and other relevant criteria. The result of this review would be documented and you (the permit holders) were to be notified of same by the December 31, 2006 date two years prior to the expiration (December 31, 2008) of all recreation residence permits currently issued on the PSICC.

Enclosed please find a copy of a Decision Memo (DM) which includes all recreation residence tracts (both groups and individual lots), that have been found to be consistent with the LRMP and all other criteria. The designated lots/tracts noted in the enclosed DM will, provided that they are in compliance with all terms and conditions contained in the currently issued permits prior to their December 31, 2008 expiration, be reissued for a new 20 year term on or before January 1, 2009.
