Wildlife

- Common game animals include elk (*left*), mule deer (*right*), pronghorn antelope, dove, quail, and turkey. Over 235 bird species present on the Grassland provide excellent bird watching opportunities.



- Comanche NG is sanctuary to many threatened and sensitive species: burrowing owl, massasauga, northern harrier, ferruginous hawk, mountain plover, long-billed curlew (*right*), loggerhead shrike, grasshopper sparrow, swift fox, black-tailed prairie dog, plains leopard frog. Also, the grasslands are in the migratory route for the threatened bald eagle and endangered whooping crane. The Comanche NG is currently monitoring population trends of these species.
