

## REGULATED CLOSURE PROCLAMATION 01

### Portions of the Klamath-Lake Forest Protection District

NOW, THEREFORE, I, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the provisions of ORS 477.535 to 477.550, do hereby proclaim and designate said described land to be under a Regulated Closure as of 01:00 a.m., PDT, Sunday, June 1, 2008, and, except as to the owner's legal right of entry upon their land, entry thereon is unlawful unless entrants comply with all restrictions.

#### Described land:

All lands protected by the Klamath-Lake Forest Protection District which are within one-half of one mile of the Klamath River from the Keno Dam, downstream to the Oregon/California border. Descriptions and maps of this described area are on file at the State Forester's Office in Salem, Oregon, and at the Forest Protection District office, Klamath Falls, Oregon.

#### Restrictions:


The following restrictions apply to all timber, brush and grass areas:

1. Possession of the following fire fighting equipment is required while traveling, except on state highways, county roads and driveways: one axe, one shovel, and one gallon of water or one 2½ pound or larger fire extinguisher.
2. Smoking is prohibited while traveling, except in vehicles on improved roads.
3. Open fires are prohibited, including campfires, charcoal fires, cooking fires and warming fires, except at posted locations.
4. Chain saw use is prohibited, between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.
5. Use of fireworks is prohibited.

The State Forester or an authorized representative must approve any waiver of these requirements in writing.

This proclamation shall remain in full force and effect until terminated by similar order of the forester.
