

SUSPENSION

REGULATED CLOSURE PROCLAMATION

NUMBER 21

Effective 6:00 p.m., PDT, September 22, 2008

WHEREAS, the menace to life and property heretofore existing due to weather conditions and an excessive amount of flammable debris on certain areas in the State of Oregon, has been sufficiently reduced to remove said menace to life and property on certain areas heretofore closed to regulated use.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the provisions of ORS 477.535 to 477.550, do hereby suspend Regulated Closure Proclamation 21 that was effective on July 25, 2008, in the NORTHEAST OREGON FOREST PROTECTION DISTRICT.

This suspension shall remain in full force and effect until terminated by similar order of the State Forester or an authorized representative.

Maps of the subject area may be viewed at the State Forester's Office, in Salem, Oregon, and at principal offices of the Forest Protection District.
