MMA - Changes in Payment for Services Furnished in Ambulatory Surgical Centers (ASCs) for Fiscal Year 2004

Provider Action Needed

This article describes changes in payment for services furnished in Ambulatory Surgical Centers (ASCs) during fiscal year 2004 (FY04), beginning with April 1, 2004. It reflects changes resulting from the enactment of the Medicare Prescription Drug, Improvement, and Modernization Act of 2003 (MMA) on December 8, 2003 (Section 626(a)).

Background

For fiscal year 2004, effective with services furnished on or after April 1, 2004, the increase in Ambulatory Surgical Center (ASC) payment rates will be the 2003 Consumer Price Index (CPI) for all urban consumers (U.S. city average) (CPI-U), as estimated for the 12-month period ending March 31, 2003, minus three (3.0) percentage points. Since the forecasted inflation of the CPI-U for the 12-month period ending March 31, 2003 was 3.0 percent, the ASC payment rates increase for FY04 equals zero percent (0.0 percent).

Effective for **services furnished on or after April 1**, **2004**, the ASC payment group rates will revert to the ASC payment group rates that were implemented effective October 1, 2002, which puts the rates as follows:
