Questions?

How are Junior Reef Rangers selected?

Selection for the camp is based on random selection. Children going into the 5th or 6th grade who are comfortable swimmers are eligible to apply.

Have I completed and turned in all the necessary forms?

Forms you should have completed are The Junior Reef Rangers Health /Registration form.

What is the deadline to turn in my forms?

Forms should be submitted on or before July 18th, 2pm to the War in the Pacific office located on the 2nd floor of the Casa de Espana building in Agana.

How can I contact my camper in the event of an emergency?

In the event of an emergency you may contact park ecologist Mark Capone at 671-688-9773.

What happens if my child becomes ill while at camp?

In the event your child becomes ill one of our staff members will contact the parent/legal guardian and he or she and they will be sent home.

What should I pack for my child to bring to camp?

Are there guidelines for clothing?

Campers should wear cool clothing with shoes that completely cover their feet. Clothing should be appropriate for outdoor activities.

Where is Check-In and Pick-up?
