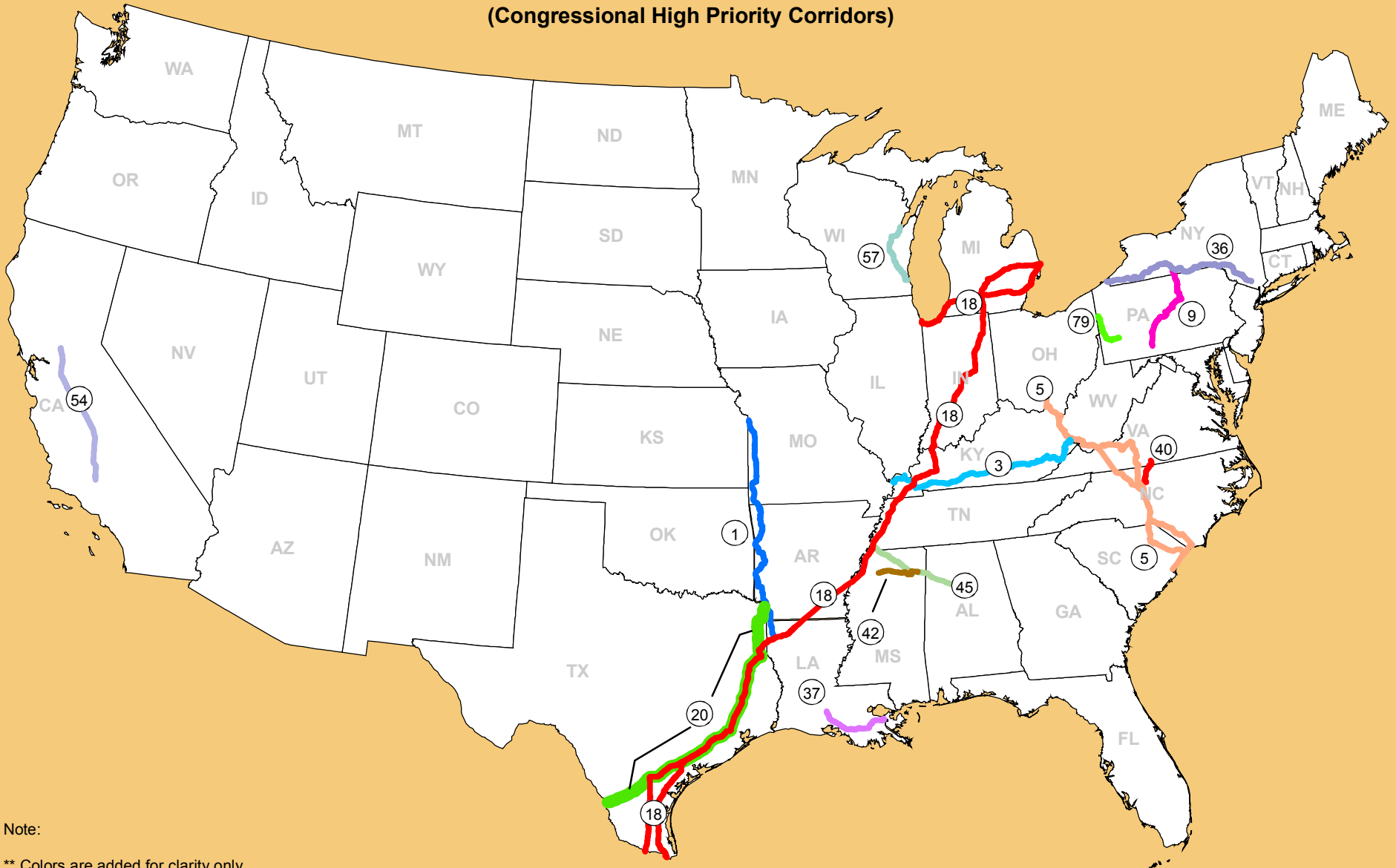




Future Interstates on the National Highway System Designated by Section 1105 of ISTEA as amended

** Future interstates have also been designated per former section 139 and current section 103 of Title 23 U.S.C. These sections are typically quite short compared to the ones depicted and are not appropriate for the scale of this map.

** Some Congressional High Priority Corridors or sections of such corridors are already existing Interstates (e.g., corridors 26, 27, 30, 38, 47, 55, 61, 63, 64, 65, 66, 67, 68, 70, 72, 75 and 78).

** Some portions of the Future Interstates have been constructed to interstate standards, opened to traffic and signed as Interstates.
