

- 1. Interstate 5 (Pacific Highway). Pave five miles from the Tualatin River to Capitol Highway, MP 289.85 to MP 295.04. Nighttime lane closures. Up to 20-minute delays. Completion: 11/2007
- 2. Interstate 205 (East Portland Freeway). Pave 8.8 miles of I-205 from the I-5 interchange to the Abernethy Bridge in Oregon City, MP 0 to MP 8.8. Add an auxiliary lane in both directions from the I-5 interchange to Stafford Road, MP 0 to MP 3.16. Nighttime lane closures. Up to 20-minute delays. Completion: 12/2007 **OTIA**
- 3. Oregon 99E (Pacific Highway East) Replace the Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard and Grand Avenue viaducts on Oregon 99E in Portland from MP 0.9 to MP 1.5. Nighttime lane closures. Up to **20-minute delays.** Completion: 10/2010
- 4. Oregon 99E (Pacific Highway East). Pave three miles of Oregon 99E from Kellogg Creek (Milwaukie) to Roethe Road (Gladstone), MP 5.97 to MP 9.22. Lane closures with flaggers directing traffic. Up to 20-minute delays. Completion: 8/2008
- 5. Oregon 99E (Pacific Highway East). Rebuild the intersection of Oregon 99E and Territorial Road, MP 18.88 to MP 19.7 (Canby), install new signals and rebuild the railroad crossing. ODOT's work is substantially complete. Territorial Road will be closed for approximately six weeks to complete the railroad crossing work. Lane closures will be in place on Oregon 99E. Up to 15minute delays. Completion: 8/2007
- 6. Oregon 213 (Cascade Highway South). Build a two-way turn lane from Conway Drive to South Henrici Road, MP 3.83 to MP 4.37 just south of Oregon City, and pave 1.5 miles from South Henrici Road to Monte Carlo, MP 4.37 to MP 5.85. Lane closures with flaggers directing traffic. Up to 20-minute delays. Completion: 8/2008
- 7. Oregon 217 (Beaverton-Tigard Freeway). Add one lane and pave 1.5 miles of northbound Oregon 217 between U.S. 26 (Sunset Highway) and Oregon 8 (Tualatin Valley Highway), MP 0 to MP 1.47. Nighttime lane and ramp closures. Up to 20-minute delays. Completion: 9/2009. OTIA

# **About OTIA**

#### **Oregon Transportation Investment Act**

The Oregon Transportation Investment Act, a series of funding packages passed by the Oregon Legislature beginning in 2001, is the first major funding boost for transportation in Oregon in 50 years.

Through 2012, OTIA projects virtually double the approximately \$700 million in transportation projects ODOT regularly delivers during every two-year budget cycle.

The OTIA program provides \$2.96 billion for highway and bridge


- construction that will: add lane capacity;
- build new interchanges;
- repave state highways and local roads and streets;
- fix or replace hundreds of aging bridges on the highway system;
- fix or replace 141 city- and county-owned bridges; and
- repave city streets and county roads.

ODOT maintains mobility for travelers and commerce

- In 2007, there will be 22 active work zones on Interstate 5.
- Unrestricted parallel routes on other state highways offer commercial truckers a travel alternative while the interstates are under construction.
- Whenever possible, road closures and delays will occur at night or during low-traffic hours.

#### OTIA helps boost Oregon's economy

- · Oregon remains open for business even as ODOT undertakes unprecedented levels of highway and bridge construction across the state.
- Every \$1 million spent on transportation projects in Oregon supports approximately 17 family-wage jobs.

The amount of construction on Interstates 5 and 84 - and throughout the state - is the largest in 50 years. During this time, ODOT is employing innovative traffic management to minimize impacts. The magnitude of construction will, however, cause some traffic delays. Whenever possible, closures will take place at night or during low traffic hours, but travelers should be prepared at all times for occasional delays.

# **Mobility**

Oregon remains "open for business" this summer even while ODOT is modernizing the state's most critical transportation corridors by repairing and replacing bridges, widening lanes and maintaining



### Tips for driving safely in work zones:

- Slow down when you see orange barrels, cones and signs-even when no construction site is visible. Hazards still exist!
- Merge as directed as soon as possible. Don't drive right up to the lane closure and then try to cut in. Keep up with the traffic flow.
- **Don't tailgate.** Keep a safe distance between you and the car ahead of you. The most common crash in a highway work zone is a rear end collision. Leave two car lengths between you and the car in front of you and never tailgate.
- Realize that it's not business as usual in a work zone. The roadway may have changed. There may be fewer lanes. There may be a detour or a flagger.
- Expect the unexpected. Normal speed limits may be reduced, traffic lanes may be changed, and people may be working on or near the road.
- Slow Down. Speeding is one of the major causes of work zone crashes but be sure to keep up with the traffic flow.
- Pay attention to the signs. Orange warning signs are there to help you and other drivers move safely through work zones. Observe the posted signs until you see the one that says you've left the work zone.
- **Obey road crew flaggers.** The flagger knows what is best for moving traffic safely in the work zone. A flagger has the same authority as a regulatory sign, so you can be cited for disobeying his or her directions.
- Stay alert and minimize distractions. Dedicate your full attention to the roadway and avoid changing radio stations or using cell phones while driving in a work zone.
- Schedule enough time to drive safely. Visit TripCheck.com or call 511 for traffic and travel information.
- Be patient and stay calm. Remember, the work zone crew members are working to improve the road and make your future drive better.

### **Oregon Road Projects Key**

The following descriptions will give you an idea of what to expect when you encounter them. The amount of delay and congestion depends on overall traffic volume, time of day, and the size of the project.

**Reconstruction** – The highway is being rebuilt. Some lanes may be shut down while others remain open to keep traffic flowing.

**Resurfacing/Paving/Overlay** – Adding pavement over existing road or structure. You will likely encounter lane closures and a lower speed limit.

Bridge work – Bridges may be built alongside existing bridges with little in the way of traffic delays. Some bridge work may require lane closures or traffic detours.


**Widening** – Widening existing roads usually requires some lane closures, but typically only for portions of the project area.

Details for specific projects listed on this map are included on the inside of this brochure. Projects are listed by highway type and route number. Information is subject to change. Projects funded through the Oregon Transportation Investment Act are denoted by OTIA in the project descriptions.

Please use caution when driving through work zones. You may encounter traffic restrictions, lane closures, detours, and delays. Watch for signs, flaggers, and pilot cars. Please drive carefully.
