Steve Proctor is a nationally recognized authority and expert in the public safety communications field. He is currently the Executive Director of the Utah Communications Agency Network (UCAN).

This quasi-state agency is charged with the operation and maintenance of a regional communications system serving 120 separate public safety governmental agencies. The system provides emergency communications for police, fire, EMS, transportation, corrections and other governmental agencies. This network supports 15,000 individual radio users. The system's critical test was the 2002 Winter Olympic Games in Salt Lake City, Utah.

A 37-year veteran of public safety communications, Mr. Proctor has also served as:

- Member of Steering committees of the National Coordination Committee (NCC);
- Member of the Public Safety Wireless Advisory Committee (PSWAC);

- Currently serves on the Executive Committee of SAFECOM, and the Federal Government Interoperability Initiative.
