Purposes of the Financial Status Report

- Records cumulative project expenditures and remaining funds
- Summarizes spending in cost categories and amount of nonfederal share
- May be used to forecast expenditures and numbers of participants that can be served

Financial Status Reports

Are based on accrued expenditures



Purposes of the Quarterly Progress Report

- Records cumulative enrollment and termination (including placement and follow-up) of participants
- Summarizes community services provided
- Summarizes participant characteristics

On-Line Reporting



On-Line Reporting

- There are two <u>required</u> SCSEP reports:
- The SF 269 Financial Status report
- The Quarterly Progress Report (QPR) the ETA 5140

When are the Reports Due?

 The reports are due 30 days after the end of the Federal Quarter.

 These dates are: October 31, January 31, April 30 and July 31.
