Special Temporary Authority

PanAmSat Corporation has filed a request for Special Temporary Authority to operate the HGS-1 satellite at 60 degrees W.L. for up to 180 days. PanAmSat has been granted Special Temporary Authority to relocate the HGS-1 satellite at 60 degrees W.L. (See File Nos. SAT-STA-19990205-00019, SAT-STA-19990216-00031, SAT-STA-19990302-00022.) PanAmSat proposes to operate the HGS-1 satellite in the 5845 - 6425 MHz and 3620 - 4200 MHz frequency bands on a non-common carrier basis.

Comments may be filed on or before MAY 14, 1999. Replies may be filed on or before JUNE 1, 1999. Responses may be filed on or before JUNE 11, 1999.
