Petition for Declaratory Ruling

Onsat Network Communications, Inc. has filed a Petition for Declaratory Ruling and Waiver. Onsat is seeking a Declaratory Ruling to permit blanket licensing for C-band satellite earth stations using very small aperture antenna (VSAT) technology, subject to frequency coordination. In addition, Onsat is seeking a waiver, if necessary, of Section 25.212 of the Commission's rules, to permit Onsat to obtain routine authorizations for 3.7 meter dishes operating in the C-band.
