ERP Project

This is an update on the proposed integrated financial, human resources, and procurement system that was the subject of *Financial Services Updates* in April and November of 2006. Much has happened since the last full update in November 2006. At that time, ODOT had completed a draft cost-benefit risk analysis report and a business case. Moreover, the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) Human Resource Services Division had signed an inter-agency agreement to partner with ODOT on the human resources functionality of an integrated system.

As DAS and ODOT continued their work, it became clear that an ERP would probably be the solution of choice. "Enterprise Resource Planning," or ERP, helps large organizations make administrative processes, such as financial, human resources and procurement, more efficient, more cost-effective and more responsive. Specifically, it's a technological solution that integrates a variety of administrative business processes into a seamless software system. It takes what might be three, four or ten different systems and pulls them together to work as one.

Currently, Central Services Division is staffing the project team with the goal of preparing a foundation for replacing TEAMS, as well as integrating core human resources and procurement functions. Additional staffing will be needed during the 2009-2011 biennium. In future biennia, ODOT will be acquiring the system and configuring it to meet business needs. DAS has designated ODOT as the pilot agency for HR functionality in the new system.

The project team has already completed the Initiation Phase of the project and is now in the Preliminary Analysis Phase. The Initiation Phase resulted in increased project understanding, definition, and governance through the formation of the ODOT ERP Project Steering Committee. The steering committee has approved both the Charter and the Project Communication Plan.

During Preliminary Analysis, the project team has been working on developing and validating "as is" business process maps. During the validation sessions, the team is also taking notes about what is working and what is not in the current environment. These sessions will continue through the end of July.

Also during the Initiation Phase, the ODOT/DAS Project Team was gearing up, with extensive research and training. Project team members have researched lessons learned by visiting public entities that have undergone similar ERP projects. This allows the team to benefit from the experience of others.

As part of the Preliminary Analysis Phase, the project is conducting software demonstrations to showcase the functionality and integration available in potential ERP software solutions. The first demonstration was April 17 when CGI presented its AMS Advantage Software. For those who missed this opportunity, there is an encore opportunity to attend an executive overview of the AMS Advantage software on July 31, 2008. The demonstrations of various software solutions continue from August through early October. If you are interested in attending, the schedule of events is shown in the table below.
